



NON-RAFFLE Fundraisers (State of MI Raffle License NOT Required)

Silent Auction: Display donated items with a “bid sheet”, after pre-designated time, the last person to bid on an item wins it (buys it).

Services Auction: Same as above, but auction off donated services, performed by students or area businesses.

Themed Gift Basket Auction: Same as above but put together themed gift baskets to auction, like a grilling basket, beach party basket, etc.

Best Parking Spot Auction: Same as above, but offer a prime parking spot for sporting events.

Best Seats in the House Auction: Same as above, but offer special seating location.

Scavenger Hunt: Charge a fee for individual participants or teams of players.

Bazaar/Garage Sale: Sell donated items. Combine with a potluck or some other type of activity.

Bring & Buy Sale: Charge people for entry and ask them to bring an item for sale.

Car Wash: Charge for washing cars, raise more money by charging an additional fee to vacuum the car. Have snacks available to purchase for waiting drivers.

Dunk Tank: Rent a dunk tank and charge participants a fee to throw the ball.

Cookbook Sale: Collect recipes from parents, etc. for inclusion in a cookbook that is sold for a profit.

Children’s Cookbook Sale: Same as above, but have students create the pages for the book by writing their favorite recipes.

Sundae Bar: Host an ice cream sundae bar, charge a fee to build a sundae.

Gift Wrapping Services: Charge a fee to have students wrap Christmas gifts.

Pizza-by-the-Slice Sale: Sell pizza by the slice.

Popcorn Sale: Sell popcorn, bring your corn poppers from home, or rent a popcorn popper.

Wrist Bands: Purchase rubber wrist bands “engraved” with an inspirational message, school logo, etc. and sell them.

Family Game Night: Host a game night with different fun games like trivia and Twister. Sell tickets to play each game and sell snacks, etc.

Student Art Sale: Students can create arts and crafts, and then sell them to raise funds. (artwork, handmade cards, drawings, handmade jewelry, etc.)

Christmas Cards: Have students create Christmas cards to sell.

Holiday Shop: Collect donations of small gifts students can purchase for family members.

Family Portrait Night: Host an evening with snacks, etc. for sale and charge a fee for a family picture package, use a digital camera and provide snaps electronically after the event.

First Aid Kits Fundraising: Have students make first aid kits to sell.

Guessing Jars: Fill a jar with candy, dog biscuits, whatever and have people guess how many are in the jar – closest guess wins.

Indoor Mini-Golf Tournament: Have students create the “holes”, charge admission.

Movie Night: Host a family movie night, charge admission and sell snacks and drinks.

Pancake Breakfast: Host a pancake breakfast, charge a fee.

Haunted House: Have students create a haunted house open to the public (for a fee) around Halloween.
