Voters living in the Allendale Public Schools district will have the opportunity to consider a bond proposal on the Aug. 6, 2024 ballot that, if approved, would result in district-wide improvements with an expected **ZERO TAX-RATE INCREASE** over the 2023 levy. The proposal comes as a result of in-depth evaluations by school staff, parents and community members to create a long-term plan that addresses current and future district goals.
