Tier 1 PBIS Implementation

Fidelity of implementation increased from 80% to 90% on the Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI).



98% of parents reported strongly or somewhat agreeing that Evergreen promotes academic success for all students



40% of students made stretch growth on their i-Ready testing - above national average of 20%



95% of students reported that staff wanted them to do well



Evergreen students math i-Ready scores match national growth average.

88.75% of students had less than 2 Behavioral Referrals during the 2023-24 school year

2024-2025 Evergreen Building Goals

Goal 1:

Classroom PBIS Implementation

By the 2025 Spring Data Review, 40% or fewer of students and 15% or fewer of staff will report classroom behaviors getting in the way of teachers being able to teach, as measured by the School Climate Survey.

Goal 2:

Family Involvement

By Spring Data Review of 2025, we will reach a 2 on item number 1.5 (sharing information with families) and increase parent report of involvement from 66% to 75%, as measured by the TFI and School Climate Survey.

Goal 3: Reading

At our Spring Data Review for 2023-2024 school year, 75% of students will have scored proficient in vocabulary as measured by i-Ready reading benchmark assessment

Goal 4: Math

At our Spring Data Review for 2023-2024 school year, 70% of students will have scored proficient as measured by i-Ready math benchmark assessment
