

Allendale High School Spring 2023-24 Data Review Summary





Tier 1 PBIS Implementation Implementation effectiveness increased from 67% to 87% on the applying the core features of School-Wide Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (SW-PBIS).



Student reports of feeling respected by other students increased 66% over the 2023-24 school year as measured by the Student School Climate Survey.



85% of students and 91.2% of families reported that school rules are clear as measured by the School Climate Surveys.




Teachers supported students with targeted lessons on behavioral expectations at the first day of school and then throughout the year based on building wide data.

2024-2025 High School Building Goals

Goal 1:

Classroom PBIS Implementation

By the Spring of the 2024-25 school year, all staff will formally implement core features of Classroom PBIS consistent with our Falcon P.R.I.D.E. expectations (Persevere, Respect, Invite, Discover, Engage).

Goal 2:

Student/Family Involvement

By the Spring of the 2024-25 school year, we will increase offerings for students & families to provide input on the implementation of core features of SW-PBIS.

Goal 3:

Acknowledgement System

By the Spring of the 2024-25 school year, 75% of students & families will report that students are acknowledged for positive behaviors as measured by the School Climate Survey.

Goal 4:

Building Community

By the Spring of the 2024-25 school year, we will see an increase in school connectedness, peer social support, cultural acceptance, and sense of belonging as measured by the student & family School Climate Survey.
